Housing Site Popularity - Discussion Document

The Questionnaire results reveal that none of the sites within the two villages in the Parish receive majority support.

However, in recognition of the requirement of the Neighbourhood Plan to identify possible sites for development, and requests to provide further sites for Affordable Housing, the table below lists the sites in order of popularity.

Dundridge Yard is the least unpopular site within the villages. Converting the existing Industrial Unit to Affordable Housing would encourage the removal of unsightly abandoned vehicles that currently dominate the site.

The field East of Meadow Close in Harberton comes next. This could be a potential site for Affordable Housing, providing the flooding issues associated with the site can be overcome, in particular the concern that any development in this field will exacerbate the existing flooding issues in the village downstream.

The least unpopular site in Harbertonford is Site 4, the field between Hernaford Road and the A381. Again, this could be a potential site for Affordable Housing providing Access and Drainage issues are overcome.
