The delegated decision on 13th July was to SUPPORT the application and forward the following comments made during consultation: The arboriculturalist's report makes no mention of the fact that these trees form part of a greater horseshoe bat strategic flyway within the South Devon SAC consultation zone. Greater horseshoe bats echolocate at particularly high frequencies which attenuate rapidly with distance. Gaps in their flight corridors can therefore be disorientating for them so it is important that gaps are avoided or mitigated as much as possible. In view of the importance of this flyway to this and several other species of bats, all protected species, some Harberton Parish Councillors would ask for a bat survey from a suitably qualified ecologist. In the event that this application is approved, councillors comment that tree work should be confined to the absolute minimum to ensure public safety and that where trees are to be felled, tall monoliths should be preferred to taking the trunks down to the base.
