Dear Cat.

I confirm the relevant diocesan committee considered your request for the longer term lease and were content in principle to help minimise costs over time. Indeed, to this end, they were also open to exploring further the freehold sale should this be of interest.

For either option to be progressed, it will be necessary for a Charities Act Report to be obtained so that we can receive independent advice on the value. Our standard practice is to require the initiating party, i.e. the Parish Council in this case, to underwrite the cost of the Report. The Report is likely to cost in the region of £600 (+/-£100) plus VAT.

Please can you confirm:

- 1. if the freehold sale is of interest
- 2. what length of lease is desired
- 3. that the Parish Council is able to provide the fee undertaking to the Charities Act Surveyor.
