## Harberton Parish Neighbourhood Plan Parish Consultation Questionnaire 2025

Last year, the Neighbourhood Plan Committee asked parishioners for feedback on various topics relating to development sites. If you took part, thank you. Since then, our independent consultants AECOM (who assess sites for suitable development) have reviewed their work and found some inconsistencies and inaccuracies. As a result, one site – **Ford Farm (Meadow Close)** – has been reclassified by AECOM:

- Then, in 2024: Green: "suitable for development with no or few constraints"
- **Now, in 2025: Amber**: "potentially suitable for development if constraints can be resolved and mitigated"

HNPSG believe this is a **material change** and means we **must re-consult** with residents before finalising the Harberton Neighbourhood Plan.

## What has changed?

The issues identified by AECOM that affect the suitability of the site are as follows:
